

NON-PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION FORM

Fill out and turn in only if you would like non-prescription medicine to be administered at school. **You must provide the medication to the camp in the original packaging**.

MEDICATION WILL BE GIVEN AT CAMP ONLY if the following guidelines are followed:

- 1. A parent or legal guardian must sign the Addlestone Hebrew Academy consent form.
- 2. The medication must be in an original container.

Please understand if you send a tablet, capsule, or liquid in a baggie or other container, WE CANNOT ADMINISTER THE MEDICATION AT CAMP.

If you send in medication in an appropriate container but do not send a signed release, WE CANNOT ADMINISTER THE MEDICATION AT CAMP. This includes any over the counter products, such as Tylenol, Motrin, Advil, cough drops or anti-acid tablets.

Safety to the students and liability of the camp are key issues for implementing these procedures in schools. These are not arbitrary rules, but they follow state and/or DHEC policy.
